No. 4042 /2020dated 02..12..2020.**ORDER**

Whereas, the Government of Odisha communicated vide Order No.6691/ R&DM (DM) dated 30.11.2020 of Chief Secretary, Odisha have promulgated the guidelines in the State of Odisha until midnight of 31.12.2020.

Whereas, in pursuance of the instructions contained at Para No.9 of the aforesaid order dated 30.11.2020 of Government of Odisha supra, I, **Dr. Ajit Kumar Mishra, O.A.S., (SAG), District Magistrate & Collector, Nabarangpur**, do hereby promulgate the following for strict enforcement and implementation -

1. **Lockdown shall be enforced within the Containment Zones till 31st December, 2020.**
2. **The following activities in areas outside the Containment Zones in the entire District will continue to remain prohibited till 31st December, 2020-**
 - I. **Public worship in religious places / places of worship will continue to remain prohibited in the entire District till 31st December, 2020.**
 - II. Large Social, political, sports, entertainment, academic, cultural, religious functions and other congregations will remain prohibited till **31st December, 2020.**
 - III. Business to Business (B2B) exhibitions shall be allowed in exhibition halls with participants up to 50% of the hall capacity with a ceiling of 100 persons subject to compliance of COVID-19 safety protocols.
 - IV. Business to Customer(B2C) exhibitions / Mela /similar functions such as Toshali Craft Mela, Shisir Saras, etc. shall remain prohibited.
 - V. Marriage related gatherings shall be allowed with a **maximum ceiling of 100 persons** and funeral/ last rites related gatherings with a maximum ceiling of **50 persons with permission of District Authority** , subject to the following conditions:
 - a. In closed spaces, a maximum of 50 % of the hall capacity will be allowed subject to the above ceiling.
 - b. In open spaces, keeping the size of the ground/ open space in view, appropriate number of persons will be allowed, subject to the above ceiling, so as to ensure maintenance of prescribed physical distancing norm.
 - c. Wearing of masks, maintaining social distancing and provision of thermal scanning & use of hand wash or sanitizer will be mandatory.

The Guidelines issued by the Government of Odisha vide Order No.4014/R&DM(DM) dated 06.07.2020(**Annexure-I**) for marriage and funeral related functions during COVID-19 pandemic shall be strictly followed with the above modifications on the ceiling of persons.

VI. All academic /Technical / Skill Development institutions will remain closed till December 31, 2020 or till such date as decided by the Departments concerned

Notwithstanding closure of Academic /Technical / Skill Development institutions, the followings will be permitted:

- a. Conduct of examinations (academic, competitive and entrance tests), evaluation and other administrative activities.
 - b. Online / distance learning shall continue to be permitted and shall be encouraged.
 - c. Teaching and non-teaching staff to be called to the schools with due permission by the School & Mass Education Department/ Higher Education Department for online teaching/ tele-counselling and related work, in areas outside the Containment Zones only as per Standard Operating Procedure(SOP) issued by the Ministry of Education/ Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW), Gol.
 - d. Higher Education Institutions will be permitted to open only for research scholars (Ph.D) and post-graduate students in science and technology stream requiring laboratory /experimental work.
 - e. All training activities including skill and professional development.
- VII. All Anganwadi Centres shall remain closed till 31st December 2020 and the arrangement for supply of ration to the beneficiaries shall continue.
- VIII. Large meetings of members of associations / clubs / institutions / organizations shall be avoided till December, 31,2020.
- IX. Cinema halls, entertainment complexes, swimming pools, auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places shall continue to remain closed. However, the following will be permitted to open:
- a. Open Air Theatres and similar places subject to compliance of safety protocols such as mandatory wearing of face masks, physical distancing, etc.
 - b. Swimming Pools owned and controlled by Government / recognized by the Department of Sports& Youth Services, Government of Odisha for training of sports as per SOP issued by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Gol.

3. All offices of State and Central Government and in Private Sector must ensure adherence to the SOP on preventive measures to contain spread of COVID-19 in offices issued by Department of H&FW , Government of Odisha dated 30.06.2020 (Annexure-II). Non-adherence to these guidelines will invite action under appropriate provisions of Disaster Management Act,2005.

4. The following Directives of COVID-19 Management shall be strictly followed throughout the District:

- a. **Face Coverings/ Masks:** Wearing of face cover /mask is compulsory in public places; in workplaces and in transport.(**Annexure-III**)
- b. **Physical distancing:** Individuals must maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet in public places.


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- c. **Shops and commercial establishments will ensure physical distancing and use of face cover/ mask by employees and customers. The onus of compliance to the guideline lies with the owner of the shop/commercial establishment, who shall be liable for any violation which may lead to penal action including closure/sealing of the premises.**
 - d. **Salons, Spas, Beauty Parlors and Barber shops shall ensure all safety precautions, disinfections and sanitization before and after service of each customer. The onus of compliance to the guideline lies with the owner, who shall be liable for any violation which may lead to penal action including closure/sealing of the premises.**
 - e. **Spitting in public places will be punishable with fine, as prescribed in accordance with laws, rules or regulations.(Annexure-IV).**
 - f. **Consumption of liquor, paan, gutka, tobacco etc. in public places is prohibited.**
5. **There shall be no restriction on inter-State and intra –state movement of persons and goods as well as Passenger Buses. No separate permission/ approval e-permit will be required for such movements.**
 6. **Activities allowed / to be allowed under the Guidelines issued by the Government vide Order No.6691/R&DM(DM) dated 30.11.2020 shall be performed in accordance with appropriate guidelines/ SOPs issued by the Central/ State Government from time to time. Web-link /URL of some of these SOPs issued by the Government of India are available at Annexure-V.**
 7. **Outdoor movement of (a) persons above 65 years of age,(b) persons with co-morbidities , (c) pregnant women and (d) children below the age of 10 years is prohibited ,except for essential and health purposes till November 30, 2020.**
 8. **Aarogya Setu app enables early identification of potential risk of infection and thus acts as a shield for individuals and the community. With a view to ensuring safety in offices and workplaces, employers on best effort basis should ensure that Aarogya Setu app is installed by all employees having compatible mobile phones. All the individuals are advised to install the Aarogya Setu application on compatible mobile phones and regularly update their health status on the app. This will facilitate timely provision of medical attention to those individuals who are at risk.**
 9. **As per Rule 2(ii) of Odisha COVID-19 Regulation, 2020, the Additional District Magistrate, Nabarangpur/ CDM&PHO, Nabarangpur/ Sub Collector, Nabarangpur/ all Tahasildar /all Block Dev. Officers / Executive Officer, Municipality, Nabarangpur & Umerkote are empowered to act to take all necessary actions for enforcement and implementation of aforesaid guidelines. Local police shall render necessary assistance as and when requisitions by the aforesaid officers.**

Any person found violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and Regulations issued thereunder besides, legal action under Sec.188 of the Indian Penal Code and other legal provisions as applicable. Extracts of these penal provisions are at **Annexure-VI**.
