Objective:

To support women affected by violence, ensuring immediate, emergency, and non-emergency assistance under one roof in a safe, secure, and sensitive environment.

Key Services Provided:

1. Emergency Response & Rescue: Immediate assistance and rescue of women affected by violence.
2. Medical Assistance: Providing medical care, first aid, and referral services for further treatment.
3. Psychological Counseling: Professional counseling services to support mental well-being and emotional recovery.
4. Legal Aid and Assistance: Support in filing complaints, accessing legal aid, and navigating the judicial process.
5. Temporary Shelter: Providing safe and secure temporary shelter to women and their children in distress.

6. Police Assistance: Coordinated support for filing FIR and police-related procedures.
7. Referral Services: Linkage with specialized service providers such as hospitals, legal services, and other government departments.
8. Follow-up and Rehabilitation Support: Post-crisis support including vocational training, social reintegration, and long-term rehabilitation.

Through its integrated service model, the OSC has successfully provided critical assistance to women facing domestic violence, sexual harassment, trafficking threats, and other social injustices in the region.
