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# **1. IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

## **1.1 Legal Framework**

This Tender Document is issued in pursuance of the Odisha Minor Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2025, and the notification for e-lottery of minor mineral sources. All provisions herein shall be read in conjunction with the Odisha Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2016 (as amended), the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, and rules made thereunder. In the event of any conflict, the latter shall prevail.

## **1.2 Nature of E-Lottery Process**

The e-lottery process shall be a computerized random draw conducted on an authorized electronic platform for allotment of quarry leases over minor mineral sources. Selection shall be made through random allotment and not through competitive bidding of additional charges, as distinct from e-auction.

## **1.3 Disclaimer of Information**

Information contained in this Tender Document is furnished on 'as is where is' basis. Prospective applicants shall verify all data independently. The Competent Authority shall bear no responsibility for any loss or damage arising from reliance thereon.

## **1.4 Discretion of Competent Authority**

The Competent Authority reserves the right to:

- a) Update, amend, or supplement information in this Tender Document
- b) Reject all or any applications without assigning reasons
- c) Annul the e-lottery process if not satisfied with publicity or participation
- d)

## **1.5 Obligations of Applicants**

Each applicant shall:

- a) Bear all costs associated with application preparation
- b) Undertake complete review of this Tender Document
- c) Accept terms and conditions unconditionally
- d) Comply with all applicable rules and procedures

## **1.6 Public Holidays**

Deadlines falling on public holidays, Saturdays, Sundays, or declared holidays shall stand extended to the next working day.

## **1.7 Technical Issues**

Applicants shall be solely responsible for technical failures at their end. No liability shall attach to the Competent Authority.

## **1.8 Document Charges**

This Tender Document is issued free of cost.

## **2. INTRODUCTION**

### **2.1 Regulatory Authority**

The State Government of Odisha, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 15 of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, has notified the Odisha Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2016, as amended from time to time, and most recently by the Odisha Minor Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2025.

### **2.2 Process Scope**

This Tender Document is issued by the Competent Authority for e-lottery for grant of quarry leases for minor mineral sources under the amended rules.

### **2.3 Governing Provisions**

The e-lottery shall be conducted in strict accordance with:

- a) Odisha Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2016 (as amended)
- b) Odisha Minor Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2025
- c) All orders and notifications issued by the State Government
- d) Terms and conditions specified in this Tender Document

### **3. SOURCE DETAILS**

#### **3.1 Information Memorandum**

Detailed information regarding each notified mineral source is provided in the "Information Memorandum" attached as Annexure-I.

#### **3.2 Source Description**

Each source notification shall specify:

- a) Area demarcated using total station and differential GPS
- b) Classification of forest and non-forest land
- c) Details of government and private land
- d) Minimum Guaranteed Quantity (MGQ) for annual extraction
- e) Additional charge amount for minor minerals
- f) Site location and accessibility details

#### **3.3 Applicant's Due Diligence**

Intending applicants are strongly encouraged to:

- a) Review the Information Memorandum carefully
- b) Conduct site visits to assess conditions
- c) Verify location, communication, power availability
- d) Understand mineral characteristics and market conditions

## **4. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**

### **4.1 Legal Eligibility**

#### **4.1.1 Eligible Entity Types**

The following entities may participate in the e-lottery process:

- a) Indian nationals (individuals)
- b) Companies as defined in Section 2(20) of the Companies Act, 2013
- c) Partnership firms as defined in Section 4 of the Indian Partnership Act, 1932

#### **Definition of Indian National:**

- a) For individuals: Must be a citizen of India
- b) For partnership firms: ALL partners must be citizens of India
- c) For companies: Must be incorporated in India

### **4.2 Financial Eligibility**

Applicants must demonstrate financial capacity by submitting ONE of the following:

#### **Option A: Income Tax Return**

- a) Income Tax Return of the previous financial year
- b) Certified by a Chartered Accountant
- c) Showing annual income  $\geq$  amount of (Additional Charge + Royalty) for MGQ for one full year

#### **Option B: Bank Guarantee**

- a) Bank Guarantee valid for 18 months
- b) Amount  $\geq$  (Additional Charge + Royalty) for MGQ for one full year

### **4.3 Mining Dues Status**

Both applicants and family members must have no outstanding mining dues payable under the Act and rules framed thereunder.

### **4.4 Multiple Source Restrictions**

Under Rule 3A of OMMC Rules, 2025:

- a) **Per District Limit:** No person (directly or through family/related entity) shall hold more than 3 minor mineral sources simultaneously
- b) **State-Wide Limit:** No person shall hold more than 5 minor mineral sources in the State

### **Lottery Participation Limit:**

- a) Maximum 5 minor mineral sources in any district
- b) Maximum 10 minor mineral sources in the entire State

### **4.5 One Application Per Source**

Only one application from one member/family/company/firm is permitted for each notified mineral source. Violation shall result in rejection of all applications from that entity for that source.

## **5. SITE VISIT AND PRE-BID CONFERENCE**

### **5.1 Site Visit**

#### **5.1.1 Timing**

Site visits are permitted during the notice period from publication of Notice Inviting Applications (NIA) until the deadline for submission of applications.

#### **5.1.2 Procedure**

- a) Intending applicants must provide prior notice to the Competent Authority
- b) Notice via email with subject line: "Site Visit for \_\_\_\_\_ Quarry"
- c) Email address: \_\_\_\_\_
- d) Site visits conducted at applicant's cost and risk

#### **5.1.3 Site Assessment**

Applicants may assess:

- a) Site conditions and accessibility
- b) Location and proximity to infrastructure
- c) Climate and seasonal factors
- d) Availability of water, power, and transport
- e) Any other relevant factors

#### **5.1.4 Applicant's Liability**

Applicants undertake to indemnify the Competent Authority for:

- a) Any loss or damage to the site
- b) Any injury to persons with surface rights
- c) Any harm caused by applicant's acts or omissions

### **5.2 Pre-Lottery Conference**

#### **5.2.1 Information Requests**

Intending applicants may seek clarifications regarding this Tender Document by:

- a) Submitting queries in .doc, .docx, .xls, or .xlsx format
- b) Sending via email to the Competent Authority
- c) Email subject: "Queries/Request for Additional Information: E-Lottery for \_\_\_\_\_ Quarry"

### **5.2.2 Query Requirements**

Each query must include:

- a) Complete facts and relevant information
- b) References to applicable law
- c) Particulars of the person submitting query
- d) No anonymous queries will be considered

### **5.2.3 Response Timeline**

- a) Queries must be submitted on or before the specified date in the timetable
- b) Competent Authority shall respond within the timeline specified
- c) Responses shall be published on the e-lottery portal
- d) Queries and responses shall not identify the source of queries

### **5.2.4 Pre-Lottery Meeting**

- a) Date, time, and venue as specified in the timetable
- b) May be conducted in physical, virtual, or hybrid mode
- c) Maximum 2 representatives per intending applicant
- d) Representatives must provide authority letter and identity documents

### **5.2.5 Authority of Clarifications**

All clarifications issued by the Controlling Authority shall be deemed part of this Tender Document. However, non-written clarifications provided informally shall not be binding on the Controlling Authority.

## **6. REGISTRATION FOR E-LOTTERY**

### **6.1 E-Lottery Portal Registration**

#### **6.1.1 Platform Details**

The e-lottery shall be conducted on an authorized electronic platform. Applicants must register on the designated e-lottery portal:

- a) Platform: <https://www.mstcecommerce.com> (as notified by Government)
- b) Registration: One-time registration required per applicant
- c) Authentication: Mobile number and email ID verification required

#### **6.1.2 Registration Process**

- a) Visit official e-lottery portal
- b) Complete registration with valid credentials
- c) Validate mobile number and email ID
- d) Receive confirmation email

#### **6.1.3 Registration Fee**

- a) Registration fee: Rs. 1,000/- plus applicable GST
- b) Current GST: Rs. 180/- (total: Rs. 1,180/-)
- c) Non-refundable fee
- d) Payment through secure portal

#### **6.1.4 Bank Details Verification**

- a) Submit signed bank mandate form or cancelled cheque
- b) Provide accurate IFSC code
- c) Essential for electronic payment processing
- d) Any mismatch shall lead to rejection

## **6.2 Application Fee and Earnest Money Deposit:**

Application fee and EMD must be paid by the applicant (NEFT/RTGS) through "Pay Pre-Bid EMD " link available in applicant's dashboard. The applicant should check the EMD Ledger link after making the payment and the same amount should be reflected in this link. A non-refundable application fee of Rs. 10000/- Shall be deducted from the applicant's available Pre BID EMD wallet for participation in a particular event. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), calculated as per rule, shall be deducted from the applicant's available Pre BID EMD wallet for participation in a particular event. The earnest money shall be a fixed amount calculated on the basis of factors as mentioned in Tender document. Applicants are to enclose a copy of their EMD ledger regarding proof of deposit of application fee and EMD amount.

### **6.2.1 Application Fee**

- a) Non-refundable application fee: Rs. 10,000/-
- b) Application fee must be paid by the applicant (NEFT/RTGS) through "Pay Pre-Bid EMD" link available in applicant's dashboard.
- c) Must be deposited before submission of application

### **6.2.2 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)**

- a) Amount: 10% of (Additional Charge for one year + Royalty for MGQ for one year)
- b) Calculated as specified in the Notice Inviting Applications
- c) Deposited through EMD wallet on portal
- d) Refundable for unsuccessful applicants

## **6.3 Documents to be Uploaded**

Each applicant must upload the following documents through the online platform:

### **6.3.1 Mandatory Online Documents**

- a) Affidavit: No mining dues outstanding against applicant or family members
- b) Affidavit: No other family member participating for this source
- c) Proof of Rs. 10,000/- application fee payment
- d) Earnest Money Deposit: Proof of 10% deposit
- e) Income Tax Return (previous financial year) OR Bank Guarantee (18-month validity)
- f) GST Registration Certificate
- g) Any other documents as specified in notice.

### **6.4 Offline Submission**

#### **6.4.1 Physical Document Submission**

All original documents and proofs must be submitted in a sealed cover:

- a) Superscript cover with: Tender Number, Date, Source Name, Source Code
- b) Submit through registered courier, speed post, or RP
- c) Delivery to: Competent Authority's office address
- d) Deadline: As specified in the timetable (before technical evaluation)

#### **6.4.2 One Bid Per Source**

- a) Applicant must submit one bid (application) for one source only
- b) Submit in single envelope
- c) Multiple applications for same source shall be rejected

#### **6.4.3 Conflict Resolution**

In case of conflict between electronic and physical documents:

- a) Physical documents shall prevail
- b) BUT physical documents accepted ONLY if online submission exists
- c) Absence of online submission = automatic rejection

## **7. APPLICATION SUBMISSION PROCESS**

### **7.1 Application Format**

All applications shall be submitted using Form-M (Annexure-II) as prescribed.

### **7.2 Required Information**

Applicants must provide:

- a) Name and address (individual/firm/company)
- b) Nationality and citizenship proof
- c) Professional details
- d) Existing mining interests (leases held or applied for)
- e) Proposed use of mineral (manufacturing/sale/other)
- f) Previous mining/quarrying experience
- g) Financial resources available
- h) Anticipated investment in operations
- i) Any additional relevant information

### **7.3 Declarations**

Applicants must declare:

- a) All particulars furnished are correct and complete
- b) Willingness to abide by tender terms and conditions
- c) Compliance with OMMC Rules, 2016 (as amended)
- d) No false or misleading information provided

### **7.4 Authorization**

If application is signed by authorized agent:

- a) Power of Attorney must be attached
- b) Agent must present authority at all interactions
- c) Full responsibility remains with applicant

## **8. TECHNICAL EVALUATION AND SELECTION**

### **8.1 Technical Application Evaluation**

#### **8.1.1 Evaluation Criteria**

The Technical Committee shall evaluate applications for:

- a) Receipt in prescribed format with all required documents
- b) Timely submission (on or before closing date and time)
- c) Electronic submission through designated platform
- d) Completeness and accuracy of information
- e) Absence of conditions or qualifications
- f) Only one application per applicant per source
- g) Compliance with eligibility conditions
- h) Any other relevant parameters

#### **8.1.2 Eligibility Determination**

The Technical Committee shall verify:

- a) Applicant is Indian national/eligible entity
- b) Financial capacity demonstrated (ITR or BG)
- c) No outstanding mining dues
- d) No disqualification under Rules
- e) Compliance with family/entity restrictions
- f) Single source limitation compliance

#### **8.1.3 Technical Openings**

- a) Date: As specified in timetable
- b) Attendance: Applicants may witness opening
- c) Process: Online applications opened in presence of applicants
- d) Recording: Proceedings documented and archived

## **8.2 Technically Qualified Applicants (TQA)**

### **8.2.1 Declaration of TQA Status**

Only applicants meeting all eligibility conditions shall be declared as "Technically Qualified Applicants" and eligible for e-lottery.

### **8.2.2 Intimation**

- a) Intimation date: As specified in timetable
- b) Communication: Via email to applicants
- c) Format: Details of TQA status and next steps
- d) No explanation for rejection required

### **8.2.3 No Obligation to Disclose Disqualification Reasons**

The Competent Authority is NOT obliged to provide any explanation or clarification regarding disqualification.

## **8.3 E-Lottery Conduct**

### **8.3.1 Minimum Participation**

E-lottery shall be conducted only if:

- a) At least 2 Technically Qualified Applicants are selected
- b) Otherwise, the lottery shall be annulled
- c) Fresh notification shall be issued

### **8.3.2 Lottery Process**

- a) Date and time: As specified in timetable
- b) Platform: Authorized electronic lottery system
- c) Method: Computerized random selection
- d) Transparency: Recorded and verifiable process
- e) Witness: TQAs may observe lottery

### **8.3.3 Selection Announcement**

- a) Announcement date: Within 7 days of lottery

- b) Communication: Official notification with all details
- c) Format: Form-F (official intimation format)
- d) Public notification: On e-lottery portal and office

## **9. SECURITY DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT**

### **9.1 Security Deposit Calculation**

#### **9.1.1 Deposit Amount**

The selected applicant shall deposit an amount calculated as follows:

**Security Deposit =  $[\frac{1}{4} \times (\text{Annual Royalty} + \text{Annual Additional Charge} + \text{Annual DMF} + \text{Annual EMF})] - \text{EMD Already Deposited}$**

Where:

- a) Annual amounts calculated on MGQ specified in notification
- b) DMF = 10% of Royalty
- c) EMF = 5% of Royalty
- d) EMD = Earnest Money already deposited

#### **9.1.2 Time for Deposit**

- a) Period: Within 15 days of intimation of selection
- b) Additional 15 days: Competent Authority may grant for genuine reasons if delay not attributable to applicant
- c) Default consequence: Selection annulled, applicant debarred for 5 years

## **9.2 Interest-Free Security Deposit**

### **9.2.1 Nature of Deposit**

- a) Security deposit held as interest-free security
- b) Combined with EMD already paid
- c) Held throughout lease period
- d) No interest accrued or payable

### **9.2.2 Refund Conditions**

The security deposit shall be refunded after lease expiry PROVIDED:

- a) All lease conditions have been fulfilled
- b) No violation of lease terms
- c) All dues paid
- d) Quarry restoration completed as required

### **9.2.3 Forfeiture**

The security deposit (wholly or partially) shall be forfeited upon:

- a) Violation of any lease condition
- b) Non-payment of dues
- c) Unauthorized mining
- d) Environmental damage
- e) Any other breach of lease

### **9.3 Statutory Cost Recovery**

The selected applicant shall also pay (non-refundable):

- a) Costs of obtaining mining plan approval (if obtained by Competent Authority)
- b) Costs of obtaining environmental clearance (if obtained by Competent Authority)
- c) These costs shall be deducted from deposit if unpaid

## **10. GRANT OF QUARRY LEASE**

### **10.1 Conditions for Lease Grant**

The quarry lease shall be granted to the selected applicant upon fulfillment of:

#### **10.1.1 Preconditions**

- a) Payment of security deposit
- b) Receipt of security deposit by State Government
- c) Compliance with all eligibility conditions
- d) Successful site visit and assessment

#### **10.1.2 Statutory Clearances**

Before execution of lease deed, applicant must obtain:

- a) **Mining Plan Approval** (from Competent Authority)
- b) **Environmental Clearance** (from environmental authorities)
- c) **Consent to Establish (CTE)** (from SPCB)
- d) **Consent to Operate (CTO)** (from SPCB)
- e) **Recommendation of the concerned Grama Panchayat:** As per Sub-rule 6 of Rule 4 of Odisha Minor Mineral Concession (Amendments) Rules -2025.

#### **Timeline for Obtaining Clearances:**

- a) Standard period: 6 months from date of selection intimation
- b) Extension period: Additional 3 months (or as authorized by Government)
- c) Extensions granted only for delays beyond applicant's control
- d) Failure to obtain within stipulated time: Lease annulled, EMD/Security forfeited

### **10.1.3 Lease Deed Execution**

The selected applicant must execute quarry lease in Form-N within:

- a) **3 weeks** from date of selection intimation IF mining plan and environmental clearance already obtained
- b) **3 weeks from receipt of all statutory documents** if clearances obtained during the 6-month period

#### **Extension Provision:**

- a) Competent Authority may extend for genuine reasons
- b) Extension not exceeding 3 months
- c) Delay must not be attributable to applicant

#### **Penalty for non-execution:**

- a) Lease deed not executed within stipulated period: Selected applicant debarred from future auctions for 5 years
- b) Security deposit forfeited
- c) Fresh e-lottery conducted if applicable

## **10.2 Responsibilities of Lease Holder**

### **10.2.1 Environmental Compliance**

- a) Applicant obtains Mining Plan approval and Environmental Clearance at own expense
- b) Compliance with EIA and EMP conditions mandatory
- c) Compliance with Environmental Clearance conditions mandatory
- d) Responsibility for environmental management throughout lease period

### **10.2.2 Mineral Extraction and Marking**

- a) Extract only the MGQ specified in notification
- b) Mark boundary of source according to approved mining plan with concrete pillars

- c) Display board with full lease details, holder's name, and source information
- d) All marking and display work at lessee's own expense

### **10.2.3 Mining Plan Compliance**

- a) Extract minerals strictly as per approved mining plan
- b) Follow all conditions stipulated in mining plan
- c) No deviation without written approval
- d) Compliance verified during regular inspections

## **11. PAYMENTS BY THE SELECTED APPLICANT**

### **11.1 Recurring Payments**

After grant of quarry lease, the lease holder must make the following annual payments:

#### **11.1.1 Royalty**

- a) Amount as per Schedule-I and II of OMMC Rules, 2016
- b) Payable on actual quantity extracted
- c) Rate may be revised by Government
- d) Revised rate applicable if higher than sanctioned rate

#### **11.1.2 Additional Charge for Minor Minerals**

- a) Amount as quoted during e-lottery
- b) OR as notified by Government from time to time
- c) Payable on annual minimum guaranteed quantity
- d) Non-waivable obligation

#### **11.1.3 District Mineral Foundation (DMF)**

- a) Amount: 10% of annual royalty
- b) Payable to DMF account
- c) Used for community development in mining area

#### **11.1.4 Environment Management Fund (EMF)**

- a) Amount: 5% of annual royalty
- b) Payable to EMF account
- c) Used for environmental restoration and management

#### **11.1.5 Dead Rent and Surface Rent**

- a) Annual fixed payment as per Schedule-I
- b) Payable on leasehold area

- c) Increases may be notified periodically
- d) Mandatory payment regardless of extraction

### **11.1.6 Compensatory Afforestation**

- a) Amount determined by forest authority
- b) Payable if forest land diverted
- c) Non-refundable contribution
- d) Part of lease conditions

## **11.2 Payment Timing**

### **11.2.1 Quarterly Payments**

Under Rule 32(3) of OMMC Rules 2025:

- a) All payments made quarterly in advance
- b) First installment due before lease deed execution
- c) Subsequent installments due at quarter commencement

### **11.2.2 Payment Heads**

All payments credited to Head of Accounts as notified by State Government from time to time.

## **11.3 Price Cap on Minor Minerals**

Under Rule 47A of OMMC Rules 2025:

### **11.3.1 Maximum Sale Price (MSP)**

Sale price of any minor mineral at quarry head shall NOT exceed MSP determined and notified by State Government.

### **11.3.2 Compliance and Violation**

- a) Strict adherence to capped price mandatory
- b) Violations attract penalties under Rule 51
- c) May lead to suspension or cancellation of lease
- d) Periodic review and revision by Government based on cost changes

## **12. OTHER PROVISIONS**

### **12.1 Returns and Reporting**

#### **12.1.1 Annual Return**

- a) Lessee must submit Form-P annual return to Competent Authority
- b) Monthly online return regarding production and dispatch
- c) Return of minerals extracted
- d) All in compliance with Rules and regulations

#### **12.1.2 Inspection and Record Keeping**

- a) Lessee must provide reasonable inspection facility to Competent Authority
- b) Inspection of quarry and accounts/records permitted
- c) Inspection by authorized Government officers
- d) As per provisions of Rule 33(16) and 33(17) of OMMC Rules

### **12.2 Boundary Marking and Display**

#### **12.2.1 Concrete Pillars**

- a) Mark boundary of source with concrete pillars
- b) Location per approved mining plan
- c) Specifications as stipulated in rules

#### **12.2.2 Display Board**

- A. Display board at quarry entrance showing:
  - a) Name of minor mineral source
  - b) Source map reference
  - c) Lessee's name
  - d) Full lease details and dates

- e) Lease period
- f) Contact information

### **12.2.3 Lessee's Responsibility**

- a) All marking and display work at lessee's own expense
- b) Maintenance of pillars and board throughout lease
- c) Replacement of damaged/missing markers

## **12.3 Lease Conditions Compliance**

### **12.3.1 Mandatory Compliance**

Lessee shall strictly abide by all conditions of quarry lease as provided under:

- a) Rule 33 of OMMC Rules, 2016
- b) OMMC (Amendment) Rules, 2025
- c) All Government orders and notifications
- d) All conditions specified in lease deed

### **12.3.2 Violations and Consequences**

- a) Violation of any OMMC Rule provision: Lessee liable for legal action
- b) Serious violations: Lease cancellation possible
- c) Repeated defaults: Blacklisting for up to 5 years
- d) Ineligibility for new leases during blacklist period

### **12.3.3 Exception and Abuse Provisions**

- a) Competent Authority reserves right to cancel lease for exception or abuse
- b) Cancellation for non-compliance with management instructions
- c) Written notice shall be given before cancellation (unless imminent danger)

## **12.4 Competent Authority Powers**

### **12.4.1 Discretionary Powers**

- a) Rectify any error or deviation in lottery notification
- b) Amend or supplement tender conditions
- c) Cancel e-lottery without assigning reasons
- d) Issue additional instructions for proper management

### **12.4.2 Right of Pre-Emption**

Under Rule 33(20) of OMMC Rules 2025:

The State Government retains RIGHT OF PRE-EMPTION over all minor minerals won from leased land:

#### **Pre-emption Exercise:**

- A. State may direct lessee to sell to:
  - i. State Government directly
  - ii. Government agencies executing public works
  - iii. Project holders undertaking beneficiary-oriented projects
- B. Maximum quantity subject to pre-emption: 40% of annual production
- C. Sale price: Notified price fixed by Government for each mineral category

#### **Failure Consequences:**

- i. Failure to comply: Breach of lease conditions
- ii. Action under Rule 51 (penalty and cancellation provisions)

## **12.5 Information and Helpdesk**

### **12.5.1 Information Sources**

## **12.5.2 Assistance**

## **13. FRAUD AND CORRUPT PRACTICES**

### **13.1 Standard of Ethics**

#### **13.1.1 High Standard Required**

Applicants, TQAs, selected applicants, and their officers, employees, agents, and advisers must maintain the highest standard of ethics throughout:
